Finance Committee Report (As directed by ATM Article 26, May 13, 2017)

The cost the state is proposing is a 7.94% payroll tax on total payroll minus \$30,000 for any establishment, municipality or institution paid to the state health care trust, State House billH2987 and Senate Bill S619.

PVRSD's current cost of health insurance not including retirees is \$1,680,588. This is based on the April 2018 health insurance bill (\$197,458 X12mo. = \$2,369,496), minus the cost of the retiree portion (\$10,726 X 12mo. = \$128,721), then the districts portion of this total, which is, 1,680,588 or% 75. The Leyden portion of the PVRDS budget last year was %6.03 so the same portion of the total health insurance cost would be \$101.339.

Assuming H2987 and S619 were currently enacted, the health insurance cost for the district this year would have been \$659,171 (7.94% of \$8,301,898) and Leyden's portion would have been \$39,748 (%6.03 of \$659,171). Based on this year's numbers, this would be a savings of \$1,021,417 for PVRSD and a savings of \$61,591 for the town of Leyden.

Employees pay a payroll tax of %2.5. A salary of \$30,000 would cost the employee \$750/year.

ARTICLE 24-

To see if the Town will vote to approve the revisions of the Leyden Zoning Bylaw, Section 2., Sub-section 2.3, paragraph B, as presented below with revisions in gray and <u>underlined</u>, or take any vote or votes in relation thereto:

- B. No dwelling or structure shall be erected nearer than fifty (50) feet to the <u>Road Right of Way</u> or nearer than forty (40) feet to either side or back <u>property</u> lines, except that the Planning Board may grant a Special Permit to erect a dwelling or structure no nearer than <u>ten</u> (10) feet to the <u>Road Right of Way</u> and/or <u>ten</u> (10) feet to the side or back <u>property</u> lines upon its determination that a) in the case of <u>Road Right of Way</u> or, the reduced setback will not be inconsistent with the character of the neighborhood and/or b) in the case of side or back <u>property</u> lines, the reduced setback will not be detrimental to the abutting property.
- C. Any request for a Special Permit for a reduced setback must contain a Survey Plan stamped by a registered surveyor. The Survey Plan must delineate the property lines including the Road Right of Way if it is different than the actual property line and the proposed structure footprint. The Planning Board may request that corner pins and stakes be placed onsite for an onsite review.
- D. Any request for a Special Permit for a reduced setback from the Road Right of Way will require the Highway Superintendent be consulted for review of the proposal. The Fire Chief must be consulted for all setback reduction requests.
