- -Powerlines are across the road
- -All quotes under 50k
- -Peter Tuzinski: Does the board know exactly which trees are coming down?
- -All poles will stay in a 3-5 foot radius of current location
- -Emily motions to recommend the marked trees removed, Warren seconds, All vote in favor of removal
- -Discussion about Scenic Roads: town voted all roads in Leyden are scenic roads in the 90s Jim suggests planning board addresses this language in the next meeting
- -Peter and Warren say the dirt roads in Leyden were made scenic roads in the 80s to preserve the scenic nature of the town
- -Peter talks about Frizzell Hill project- state funds were accepted and many trees were taken down thus they introduced the scenic roads legislation
- -Peter thinks it's pointless to revisit, says no one has complained about the scenic road legislation
- -Jim brings up stone wall rules and people tearing them down, wants to raise awareness about scenic roads
- -Audience agrees information needs to be spread differently
- -Peter says planning board used to enforce building regulations and the Franklin County Building Inspectors don't know Leyden bylaws well
